STEP 5: Agreement to insurance requirements

Platte River Power Authority requires liability insurance with minimum limits of \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit for each occurrence and Certificate of Workman's Compensation Insurance, statutory level.

If admitted to the pool, contractor agrees to provide Certificates of Insurance indicating Platte River Power Authority and CLEAResult each as an **ADDITIONAL INSURED**. See Contractor Guide for wording and detailed instructions.

These Certificates of Insurance shall also contain a valid provision or endorsement that these policies may not be canceled, terminated, changed or modified without **thirty (30) days** written notice to all Certificate Holders.

STEP 7: What to expect next:

If your company meets minimum standards for all of the above, Efficiency Works will provide you with a contractor agreement. After you return the agreement, our Contractor Services Manager will reach out to the contact person listed above to schedule a 2-day technical training for staff that will be installing measures eligible for rebates within the program (if not already taken). In addition, the Contractor Agreement requires that all staff are lawfully present and eligible to work in the United States.

Once the technical training is completed, you are eligible to install measures through the program. The Contractor Services Manager will work with you to schedule project walk-throughs to ensure that your company representatives understand the rules of the program and are meeting the quality standards set forth in the Contractor Guide. After the initial walk-throughs, approximately 10% of your jobs will be reviewed through the Quality Control process.
