Re: 5-year recertification reports for solid waste disposal facility run-on and run-off control system plan in accordance with CCR Rule 40 CFR 257

Ms. Pierce:

In accordance with the Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Rule, 40 CFR 257 subpart D, Platte River Power Authority (Platte River) has worked with AECOM to complete the 5-year recertification reports for solid waste disposal facility run-on and run-off control system plan at the Rawhide Energy Station. AECOM completed the recertification for the ash monofill and placed these findings in a report in accordance with 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Parts 257 requirements under the CCR Rule. This completed document has been placed in the operating record and is also located on Platte River's publicly available website.

The bottom ash transfer (BAT) impoundments and reclaim pond are now inactive and are in active closure. Therefore, the inactive waste units are exempt from the 5-year recertification of the run-on and run-off control system plan. AECOM has written a letter clarifying this documentation requirement. This letter has been placed in the operating record and is located on Platte River's publicly available website.
